ORDER

For the reasons stated in the accompanying Memorandum Opinion, it is, this 14th day of January 2022 by the United States District Court for the District of Maryland, ORDERED:

- 1) Plaintiff's Motion to Amend (ECF 95) is GRANTED in part and DENIED in part;
- 2) Plaintiff may file a Second Amended Complaint, due by **January 28, 2022**, that adds SMG as a defendant to claims for violation of plaintiff's First Amendment rights as to free speech, free exercise of religion, establishment of religion, and assembly; adds claims against SMG for breach of contract, promissory estoppel, and declaratory judgment; and adds claims against the City Defendants for tortious interference with contractual relations and declaratory judgment. The Second Amended Complaint may not include a fraud claim against SMG or a claim against defendants for future injunctive relief;
- 3) Defendants' Motion to Dismiss (ECF 52) is DENIED, as moot, and without prejudice;
- 4) Defendants shall answer or otherwise respond to the Second Amended Complaint within 21 days of the date of docketing of plaintiff's Second Amended Complaint.
