ORDER

THIS MATTER having come before the Court on March 25, 2025, for oral argument on Plaintiff Amanda Jones's motion to stay the proceedings (ECF No. 11); and the Court having considered the papers in support of and in opposition to the motion (ECF Nos. 11, 17, 18), as well as arguments of counsel; and for the reasons set forth in the Opinion placed on the record on this date, which are incorporated herein at length; and for good cause shown;

IT IS on this 26th day of March 2025,

ORDERED that, Plaintiff's motion to stay the proceedings, (ECF No. 11), is **DENIED**; and it is further

ORDERED that, on or before **April 1, 2025**: (1) the parties shall submit a stipulated voluntary dismissal order pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 41(a)(1)(ii), or (2) if the parties cannot agree to enter into a stipulated voluntary dismissal of this case, then Plaintiff shall file any motion for voluntary dismissal, pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 41(a)(2). Defendant's opposition to any such motion, if any, shall be filed on or before **April 8, 2025**. Plaintiff may file a reply by **April 15, 2025**; and it is further

ORDERED that the Clerk of the Court is requested to terminate the motion appearing at ECF No. 11.
